ORDER CONFIRMATION

Your Swank Account Executive will give you an immediate verbal confirmation in addition to mailing you a written confirmation. Call if your written confirmation is not correct. Confirmations can also be obtained via e-mail.

PRICING AND PAYMENT

Prices are for a one day rental. Additional fees apply for extra days. If you charge admission, your movie rental rate is a flat rate versus 50% of your gate receipts, whichever is greater. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice. Pricing is subject to change based on success of title, audience size and release date.

DELIVERY OF YOUR MOVIE

Your movie arrival times may vary depending on the media you selected:

- DVD - approximately 2 days before screening
- 35mm - approximately 1 day before screening
- Digital Cinema Player download - approximately 7 days before screening

A full inspection of your film is required upon arrival. You must notify Swank at least one (1) business day prior to your screening regarding undelivered or damaged items to avoid full rental fees.

PIN-PLAY CODE

Pin Play is Swank's latest security measure used for screening pre-home movies. This security code ensure we can continue to provide blockbuster content before it's available anywhere else. A unique 4 digit code is assigned to each pre-home DVD and must be entered to play your movie. The code will be delivered to you via email up to 5 business days prior to your scheduled screening.

RETURNING YOUR MOVIE

Movies must be returned on the first business day following the scheduled showing. Charges may apply for any delay in returning movies. Future bookings are dependent upon your timely return of all movies! Swank includes postage for your convenience on DVD shipments. The shipping and handling charge includes postage for delivery to you and return to Swank. You are responsible for the movie while it is in your possession and until Swank receives it.

CANCELLATION

Any film may be cancelled without obligation provided that Swank Motion Pictures, Inc. receives written notification fourteen (14) days before the film is shipped, or the full rental and handling charges must be paid.

CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES IN A DISCOUNTED PACKAGE PROGRAM ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PRICE ADJUSTMENT: THE PRICES OF THE REMAINING FILMS BOOKED IN THAT PACKAGE WILL BE INCREASED TO THE FULL RENTAL RATE PRIOR TO THE PACKAGE DISCOUNT.

If your film has already shipped out, you are responsible for payment at that time.

SHOW DATE CHANGES

All show date changes must be made in writing and received by Swank ten (10) days before the film is shipped or the full rental and handling charges must be paid. If you have an unforeseen circumstance that prevents you from notifying us of a show date change, you have one year in which to reschedule the same film for no additional license fees.

ADVERTISING GUIDELINES

These motion pictures are specifically licensed for non-theatrical showings only. **Advertising through media such as public radio, public television or general public newspaper is strictly prohibited.** Advertising of the showings is strictly limited to your campus grounds or premises of your organization. Advertising must be used exclusively to inform students, members or staff of movie showings via on-premises bulletin boards, websites, mail boxes, campus newspapers, campus radio or like services. Any violation of the advertising guidelines may result in cancellation of your program without notice. Check with your Swank Account Executive for suggestions on ways you can promote your movies.

COPYRIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Your order is for a limited license to exhibit only to the agreed upon time and place. Violation of this is subject to penalties set forth in the Federal Copyright Act. No movie or portion thereof may be copied or duplicated in any manner. Any type of electronic transmission may only be done with pre-approved written permission in rare circumstances and are subject to different rates.
