Project Greenlight, the documentary series chronicling the search for a first-time director and exploring the filmmaking process, returns to HBO for an all-new, eight-episode season. Executive produced by Ben Affleck and Matt Damon, who were executive producers of the previous two seasons on HBO (in 2001 and 2003), the new season of *Project Greenlight* spans the entire filmmaking process, taking a revealing, uncensored look at the challenges facing a firsttime director. The show begins with a digital competition, following the winner from pre-production and casting through principal photography and post-production. Equipped with a Hollywood-vetted script and surrounded by a team of industry professionals, including award-winning filmmaking duo Peter and Bobby Farrelly (who serve as judges), the fledgling director must learn to cope with pressure from the studio and producers, survive on-set politics, and lead a veteran cast and crew, all while trying to deliver a viable movie – on schedule and on budget.
