## HBO Documentary Films Rated TVPG; 2016

Nominated for a 2016 Academy Award® for Best Documentary Short, this 40-minute documentary follows the story of Saba, a young woman from the Punjab region of Pakistan, who was shot and left for dead by her father and uncle after marrying Qaiser, a man once promised to her by her family. Told through the lens of a true love story, the film is a scathing examination of the contradictions between modernism and tradition within Pakistani society, as Saba struggles with pressures to “forgive” the relatives who tried to kill her – a pronouncement that would set them free. In this masterful work of high-risk journalistic storytelling, award winning filmmaker Sharmeen Obaid-Chinoy (*Saving Face*) uncovers the complex and violent forces faced by women in Pakistan, particularly as it relates to human rights and family honor.

# Becoming Mike Nichols

In the summer of 2014, Mike Nichols sat down with his friend and colleague Jack O'Brien to discuss Nichols' early career: his stint as a '50s sketch performer with The Compass Players and Second City, the comedy partnership with Elaine May that turned both into stars, and his shift to directing in the mid-'60s, when he enjoyed phenomenal success on Broadway and in Hollywood, winning acclaim as a first-time film director with *Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?* and a 1968 Best Directing Oscar® for *The Graduate*. The conversations took place over two days – one with an audience and one without – on a stage very familiar to Nichols: Broadway's Golden Theatre, where "An Evening with Mike Nichols and Elaine May" was staged 55 years earlier. As he explains in this lively and entertaining 72minute documentary (accented by photo stills and clips from some of his iconic work), Nichols' early journey was fueled by a combination of good luck, passion, talent and empathy – all geared towards finding the "part of us that comes out of the subconscious," and creating something new, memorable and thrilling.
