GLACIERS: ICE ON THE MOVE

During the Pleistocene epoch, huge sheets of ice ground over much of the Northern Hemisphere, chiseling mountains, gouging lake beds out of rock, and depositing huge boulders thousands of kilometers from their source. Students will observe how glaciers form and move, how they alter the landscape, and how they affect the lives of people who live in their vicinity. 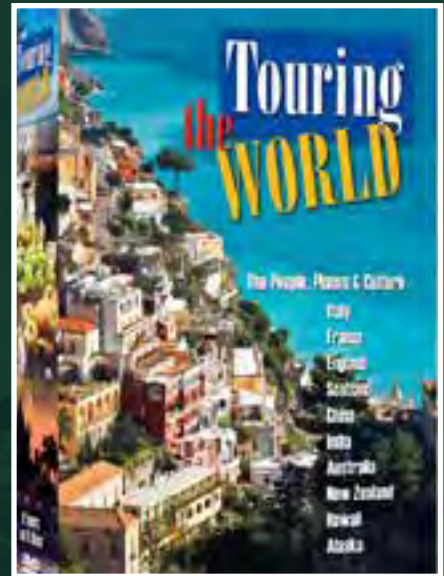

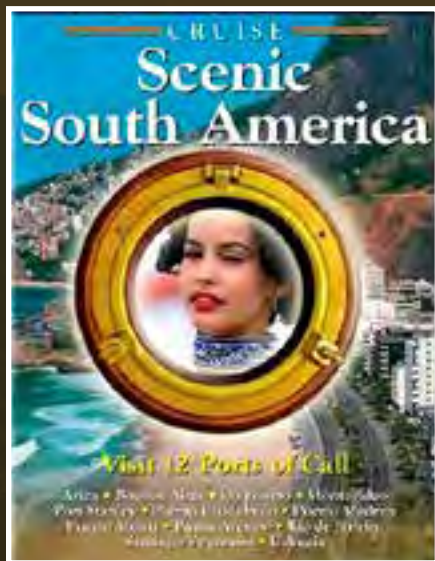

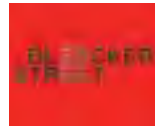
